Dear Parent or Guardian,

The highest priority for Bradford County Public Schools is to improve students' academic achievement. We believe that all children can learn and will achieve when parents are involved with their children's education. The *No Child Left Behind* legislation encourages educators, parents, and Supplemental Educational Services providers to work diligently together to incorporate additional educational services to improve student achievement in eligible Title I schools.

Your child is eligible for Supplemental Educational Services (**free tutoring**) because he/she is eligible to receive free or reduced lunch and attends a school that has been identified for Title I School Improvement. Free tutoring in language arts/reading and/or math will be offered, after school, before school, and/or on weekends. The tutoring may be offered at your child's school, in your home, at another site, or through an internet-based service. Transportation to and from the tutoring site will not be provided.

Each child has unique educational needs. Therefore, you decide which provider's services best meet your child's needs. You can choose different Supplemental Educational Service providers for each of your children – *it is your choice*. To help you make an informed choice, please review the enclosed information. More information on the providers is available on the provider's listed web site. You may also call Carol Clyatt at 966-6816 for further information or concerns or if you would like assistance in choosing a provider.

If you wish to have your child participate in this program, select three providers, in the order of preference, on the enclosed Title I Supplemental Educational Services Notice of Intent 2009-10 form. If your first choice is not available, the second or third choice will be assigned. Please return this form to the Title I office **by September 8, 2009**. Once selections have been finalized, you will be contacted by the provider. Tutoring services will begin by Oct. 15, 2009.
